#### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

To avoid denial/delay in the processing of your application, please be advised of the following:

- 1. All documents required for submission must be complied with, arranged in the order as listed in the Checklist of Documentary Requirements (CDR), compiled in a legal size (8½ x 14 in.) folder and shall be submitted within the prescribed period, if applicable. Otherwise, your application shall not be accepted.
- 2. All sworn statements or affidavits must be original and duly notarized.
- 3. All civil registry documents issued in the Philippines (i.e. Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate, Death Certificate, etc.) must be original and issued by the National Statistics Office (NSO) of the Philippines.
- 4. All foreign documents must be original and authenticated by the Philippine Foreign Service Post (FSP), which has jurisdiction over the place of issuance, or by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) if said document is issued by the local Embassy in the Philippines with English translation if written in other foreign language.
- 5. If the application is filed by an authorized representative, attach a photocopy of the Bureau of Immigration (BI) Accreditation Identification (ID) Certificate or an original Special Power of Attorney (SPA) for **EACH** applicant with a photocopy of a valid government-issued ID of attorney-in-fact.
- 6. The original valid passport of the applicant must be submitted to the Central Receiving Unit (CRU) personnel or concerned frontline officer for scanning. Thereafter, it shall be returned.
- 7. It is recommended that you seek legal advice from lawyers and/or BI-accredited entities.

### Requirements for WEG application

The documentary requirements of the WEG are the following:

- 1. Letter addressed to the Commissioner of the Bureau of Immigration of the Philippines from the parent requesting the granting of Waiver of Exclusion Ground and allowing the entry of the child(ren) to the Philippines. The letter must name the adult accompanying the child and representing the parent(s) during the trip;
- 2 Affidavit of Consent of either parent of the child(ren) notarized by the Philippine Consulate General Istanbul in Turkiye and the payment of 25 USO per document
- 3. Personal appearance of the parenUs who will sign the Affidavit of Consent before a consular officer:
- 4. Photocopy of the child(ren)'s passport information page;
- 5. Photocopy of the parent(s)'s passport information page;
- 6. Copy of the child(ren)'s flight itinerary indicating the departure from the Philippines;
- 7. Copy of the invitation (from sponsoring institution or sponsoring parent) for the child(ren) to come to the Philippines;
- 8. Waiver Fee of PHP 3,120.00 per minor child
